Block of the Mystery PART H

Welcome back to the Block of the Month combination Mystery quilt! If you would like to ONLY complete the BOM, feel free to just complete the <u>FIRST</u> block and stop there. If you would like to participate in the mystery, complete both blocks and continue on to the Mystery section below it.

I would encourage you to grab random yardage, fat quarters, scraps and LOTS of 2 ½"strips for this project. The more colors the better! If you love each fabric, you will love the quilt.

Please note: You can use any colors you want for this block. I would recommend writing your substitution down or you might get lost in the directions.

Mystery Part H is comprised of one 12-inch block, one 8-inch block, and 2.5 inch strips.

Cutting Instructions for 8-inch block:

- Background Stripe
 - 5 2 7/8" squares
 - Subcut each once on the diagonal to make 10 triangles.
 - 4 − 2 ½" squares
- Yellow
 - 2 2 7/8" squares
 - Subcut each once on the diagonal to make 4 triangles.
- Teal
 - 1 2 7/8" square
 - Subcut each once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles.
- Purple
 - 1 4 7/8" square
 - Subcut each once on the diagonal to make 2 triangles.

Sewing Instructions:



1. Sew all teal triangles to a background triangle.

2. Sew a background triangle to either side of the teal triangle.





3. Sew the purple triangles to the background teal unit.



4. Sew the yellow triangles to background triangles.

5. Sew the yellow triangle units to the background squares as shown.



6. Lay out your block (mind the direction the pieces are facing!) and sew the 4 units together.




7. You're awesome!

Foundation Papers will be available for completion of a 12-inch New York Beauty block. If you would like to substitute another block because you are not a fan of paper piecing, please visit http://www.quilterscache.com/BlocksbySizeC.html and choose a 12" block that suits you.

You will need to tape the pieces together to create the complete units.

For the MYSTERY Part H,

Cutting Directions:

- From 2 ½ inch strips:
 - o 3 36.5"
 - o 1 26.5"
 - o 2 14.5"
 - o 4 6.5"

Put these 2 ½ inch strips away!

Place all of your cut 2.5" strips and the 2 blocks in a bag marked Part H. Remember to put it someplace "safe" so you'll never see it again. I mean, so you'll be able to find it again.
