

Supply List: Colorwash Hunter Star Workshop

Colorwash Hunter Star Wall Hanging: Quilt size: 20" x20"

General Supplies:

- Sewing machine with ability to sew a ¼" seam (1/4" foot if available), threaded with a neutral cotton thread in both top and bobbin
- Thread in bobbin to match backing fabric
- Large bath or beach size towel (larger than a hand towel) – to be used as a pressing surface for your design; the towel will likely get small amounts of water-soluble glue on it (glue washes out)
- Pressing sheet or parchment paper (adhesives do not stick to these materials)
- Rotary cutter with sharp blade
- Cutting mat (travel size is OK)
- Small sharp-pointed scissors
- Other usual sewing supplies (pins, extra machine needles and bobbins, seam ripper, etc.)
- Small travel size iron
- Fabric Glue stick with fine tip (e.g. Fons & Porter, Sewline, Avery, Roxanne's glue, or Elmer's school glue with special tip)
- Quilting cutting ruler (6" x 12" or 6" square is fine)
- Tweezers for grasping fabric squares (optional)
- Camera/phone w camera

Fabric Requirements:

- A wide variety of 2" square scraps – small to medium scale prints, tone-on-tone, small check or stripe fabrics work well; sorting the fabrics into color families may help save time in class
- Select fabrics in two categories: block background and contrasting star points
- You may like to work with a photo to help inspire your fabric selection – bring it to class and use as a basic guide when selecting colors and values for your project
- Extra squares can be shared – I will also have a large supply of squares available
- You can also bring other size small scraps or strips to cut into 2" squares in class if you don't want to precut a lot of 2" squares that might not be used
- Backing: 28" square of fabric for backing
- Batting: 28" thin batting
- Binding: ¼ yard (not needed for class)
