

HAWAIIAN QUILTING WORKSHOP
SUPPLY LIST

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This class will feature all aspects of Hawaiian Quilting, pattern selection, needle turn appliqué, marking the design and hand quilting. No Machines!

Janet will provide a Hawaiian Breadfruit Quilt design for you at the class.

FABRICS:

Please: have all fabrics precut prior to class

(TWO) 20" Square Background fabric (white recommended)

(THREE) 20" Square of Muslin

(ONE) 16" Squares of Focus Fabric (Bright Color – solid is best)

(TWO) 20" Square of batting (Janet uses Dream Cotton REQUEST)

Freezer Paper

BEFORE CLASS:

Please *make a quilt sandwich* with Two of the muslin pieces and One batting square from above fabric list – have it basted (we will use this as a practice piece for part 2)

NOTIONS & EQUIPMENT:

Water-erasable marking pen / pencil (to mark quilting lines)

(Recommendation: a white marking pen and blue marker)

Lightweight paper or Freezer Paper (to trace Hawaiian pattern)

Mechanical Pencil and Sharpie Marker (any color!)

Straight Pins

Appliqué Needles: #8 or #9 Sharps

Quilting Needles: #7 or #9 Betweens

Long Basting Needle

Thimble

Thread: Appliqué – match focus fabric, 50 – 60 weight

Hand quilting: match focus fabric and background fabric, 30 weight

Scissors: Large and Small sizes – MUST be sharp

Quilting Hoop

This will be a workshop to discover the art of Hawaiian Quilting!

We will start with a bit of history then move right into the FUN!

Part 1: You select and cut out a pattern from focus fabric, baste focus design onto background, discuss & review and start needle turn appliqué of your design.

This will become your finished piece – but for the class you will only start this phase and take home to finish

Part 2: Using the muslin sandwich and a mock Hawaiian design, you will learn how to mark your block and how to start the hand quilting process. This will become a sample for you to refer back to once you have finished your piece from part 1. You will receive step by step instructions on how to make a pillow with a hidden zipper!
