

# Round Robin in a Day Workshop

## Supply List

- Completed 8 ½” (8” finished) center block. This block will set the tone for your quilt and may be in any style or technique of your choosing, including just a plain 8 1/2” square block if you run out of time or sign up for the class late.
  - At least 3 yards total of fabrics you would like to see used in your quilt. Since the fabrics will be used for borders, it is recommended that at least 1.5 yards be in the form of half yard cuts (18” x 42”). Additionally, any scraps should be pressed and otherwise made sewing-ready. You are welcome to bring more than this, and please be ready to do plenty of fabric sharing with your fellow participants! However, please don’t bring your entire stash. That’s just showing off and we won’t have room for it.
  - ¼ yard fusible web for any machine appliqué you think you might want to do, if you are likely to do such a thing. NOTE: it isn’t likely that there will be time for hand appliqué in this workshop.
  - Cutting mat and rotary cutter
  - 6” x 24” ruler
  - 9 ½” or other square ruler
  - Sewing machine with instruction book
  - Extra sewing machine needles (whatever you use for piecing)
  - Neutral thread for piecing
  - Two bobbins prewound with piecing thread
  - Sewing scissors
  - Seam ripper
  - A jazzed-up and ready to go attitude!
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- ½ yard binding fabric - you may want to wait to see how your quilt turns out before choosing a binding, but this is the amount you will eventually need.\*
  - 1 yard backing fabric \*
  - 1 yard batting \*

*\* Items are **not** needed for class, but would be needed to finish the quilt*
