## Techniques Sampler Quilt-Along Instructions

## Fabric Requirements:

You can use one fabric for each color (non-scrappy) or use multiple fabrics for each color (scrappy). Each quilt uses one color for the background (medium or dark color), a light color (neutrals), and one or two medium colors, depending on which coloration style you select from the samples. You could also use multiple colors.


## Coloration 1

Background Color (dark/black): Without borders - $41 ⁄ 2$ yards
Light Color: 3 yards
Medium Color 1 (red): $11 / 2$ yards
Medium Color 2 (gold): $11 / 2$ yards

## Coloration 1/ Design 2

Background Color (dark/black): Without borders - $51 / 2$ yards
Light Color: $1 / 2$ yards
Medium Color 1 (red): $1 ½$ yards

Medium Color 2 (gold): $21 / 4$ yards
Colorations 2 \& 3
Light Color: $41 / 2$ yards
Background/medium Color 1 (blue): $41 / 2$ yards
Medium Color 2 (green/orange): 3 yards
Borders: 2 yards

## Other Supplies:

Usual quilting supplies: rotary cutter, rulers, etc.
Other recommended supplies will be listed for each of the blocks as needed; multiple methods will be discussed so that you should not need to buy any specific tool(s) unless you want to try that method/technique.
