## Cutting Instructions

The cutting instructions for each fabric set contain both a listing of pieces by size for cutting from multiple fabrics and cutting instructions for each set using a single fabric. Please note that if using the cutting instructions for a single fabric, in some cases a few more pieces will be cut than needed in the pattern.

Piece sizes marked with an * indicate fabrics that will be used in half square triangles (HST), square in a square, or similar blocks so if you like to oversize these blocks then trim to size, please add a $1 / 4$ or $1 / 2$ inch to the listed measurements.

## Fabric Set A

## Cutting instructions if cutting from a single fabric

1. Cut 8 strips 4" x WOF*
a. Cut each strip into 4 " squares (10 per strip) for 72 squares (4" x 4").
2. Cut 3 strips $37 / 8$ " $\times$ WOF*
a. Cut each strip into $37 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ squares ( 10 per strip) for 24 squares ( $37 / 8^{\prime \prime} \times 37 / 8$ "). b. Cut each square ( $37 / 8$ " $\times 37 / 8 "$ ) once on the diagonal for 48 triangles ( $37 / 8$ " x $37 / 8$ ").
3. Cut 3 strips $31 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF
a. Cut each strip into $31 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ squares (11 per strip) for 24 squares ( $3^{11 / 2 "} \times 31 / 2$ ").

Cutting instructions if cutting from a single fabric

1. Cut 8 strips 4" x WOF*
a. Cut each strip into 4 " squares ( 10 per strip) for 72 squares (4" x 4 ").
2. Cut 6 strips $31 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF
a. Cut 4 strips each into $31 / 2$ " squares ( 11 per strip) for 44 squares ( $31 / 2$ " $\times 31 / 2$ "). b. Cut 1 strip into $31 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2$ " rectangles ( 6 per strip) for 6 rectangles ( $31 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2$ ") c. Cut 1 strip into an additional 4 squares ( $31 / 2$ " $\times 31 / 2$ ") and 4 rectangles ( $31 / 2$ " $\times 61 / 2$ ").
3. Cut 2 strips $71 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF*
a. Cut each strip into $71 / 2 "$ squares ( 5 per strip) for 9 squares ( $71 / 2$ " $\times 71 / 2 "$ ).
4. Cut 2 strips $43 / 4$ " $\times$ WOF
a. Cut each strip into $43 / 4$ " squares ( 8 per strip) for 12 squares ( $43 / 4$ " $\times 43 / 4$ "). 5 . Cut

6 strips 3½" x WOF (for border)

## Fabric Set C

Number of pieces needed

Cutting instructions if cutting from a single fabric

1. Cut 2 strips $71 / 2 " \times$ WOF*
a. Cut each strip into $71 / 2$ " squares ( 5 per strip) for 9 squares ( $71 / 2$ " $\times 71 / 2$ ").
