
Whole Hourglass Blocks

Using 7 hourglass units $(6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}")$ and 28 HST units $(3\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}")$, form 7 whole hourglass blocks $(6\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2})$.

a. Sew 28 HST units into 14 double HST units $(3\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}'')$.



b. Arrange units as shown below, sew together pressing seams open. Form a total of 7 whole hourglass blocks ($6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ").



Half Hourglass Blocks

Using 10 hourglass units $(6\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}")$, 20 HST units $(3\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}")$, and 10 fabric set B rectangles $(3\frac{1}{2}" \times 6\frac{1}{2}")$, form 10 whole hourglass blocks $(6\frac{1}{2}" \times 12\frac{1}{2})$.

a. Sew 20 HST units into 10 double HST units $(3\frac{1}{2} \times 6\frac{1}{2}'')$.



b. Arrange units as shown below, sew together pressing seams open. Form a total of 10 half hourglass blocks ($6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ").
