## Pepperell Patchwork Mountains Mystery Quilt Part 5

## Block A:

- Select any strip from each of the first five numbered strip bundles/baggies and rearrange them according to the diagram. When choosing the strips, mix up the strips for a variety of fabrics. (If you don't want a scrappy quilt, use matching fabric strips.)
- Hint: To rearrange the strips easily, start with the original position the strips were cut in and rotate each strip $180^{\circ}$.
- Sew the strips together. Press the seams in the same direction.
- Square up the block to $63 / 4 " \times 8 / 4$ " (unfinished).
- Repeat for the remaining strips numbered one to five for a total of $20(16,12)$ blocks.



## Block B:

- Repeat the above steps in Block A for the strips numbered from six to ten, arranging the strips according to this diagram for a total of $20(16,12)$ blocks.
- Hint: To rearrange the strips easily, start with the original position the strips were cut in and rotate each strip $180^{\circ}$.
